
MONTE VISTA FIRST FLOOR




MONTE VISTA THIRD FLOOR

TILT TALKBACK AND AUDIENCE IMPACT INTERVIEWS -BEHIND THE CURTAINS

After each performance, Dark Sky Aerial offers the opportunity for an audience talkback conversation moderated by Garrison Garcia, founder of The Flagstaff Foundry. We view the audience as our final collaborator and sometimes the conversation can spill beyond the production itself. The talkback provides a chance to ask questions and discuss the production with the performers, directors, and creators. We invite the conversation to serve as a platform for raising questions rather than for providing answers. Talkbacks are less about the production's literal meaning than about the creative process for the directors. Dark Sky Aerial's hope is to stimulate conversations on and off set.

In collaboration with Northern Arizona University graduate student and Dark Sky Aerial company member Jordan Pletzer, audience impact surveys will be conducted following TILT. On-site, after the Saturday, 9/1 evening showing, a documentary filmmaker will be available to conduct audience impact interviews recorded on film.
